Vintage Sniper Rifle Team Matches**



**Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Sanctioned Matches Sponsored by:
The Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club (CRPC)**

Vintage Sniper Matches are a team event consisting of 2 competitors per team. Pick up teams are allowed to form on the day of the match however match officials cannot guarantee a partner will be available. New shooters are encouraged to attend with coaching and sight-in assistance available.

DATE: Sunday May 24

TIME: 8:00-8:30 A.M. Registration or to range capacity of 21 Teams. 8:30-8:45 A.M.
Squadding/Safety Briefing 9:00 A.M. Firing Commences

LOCATION: Cheyenne Rifle & Pistol Club Outdoor Range – 10 miles northwest of Cheyenne, WY. Go north on Interstate 25 to Exit 16, Horse Creek Road. West on Horse Creek Road for 3.3 miles to Telephone Road. North on Telephone Road For 2 miles. Turn East on dirt road for ½ mile to range gate. The match will be shot at the High-Power range.

ELIGIBILITY: Any competitor 12 years of age or older and a citizen of the United States may enter this match. CMP rule 3.5.3 states that the age requirement may be waived by the match sponsor upon presentation of proof of the competitor's ability to handle a service rifle safely and complete the match course of fire. A notarized Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement must be on file with the CRPC. Forms will be available at each match.

ENTRIES: This will be a team event consisting of 2 competitors per team. Team entries are to be made at the firing line the morning of the match. Pick up teams will be allowed. All competitors will be required to perform pit and scoring duties.

GENERAL: The Shotmarker Electronic Targets System will be used. Competitors should bring an electronic device with sufficient power for a full day of operation and a browser capable of accessing an internal webpage over the Range WiFi. With the electronic target system, competitors are still required to score. Paid score keepers are not permitted. Competitors may be required to assist setting up and taking down targets; failure to do so may lead to disqualification. In the event of a catastrophic failure or malfunction of the electronic target system, the Match Director will reserve the right to either delay the match or to switch to manual targets. All competitors will be required to perform pit duties if such a case arises. If a substitute puller is used, the competitor shall accompany the substitute puller and is responsible for their attendance and performance in the pits. ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per shooter. Make check or money order payable to: Cheyenne Rifle and Pistol Club

LIABILITY WAIVER: An agreement of release and waiver of liability must be signed before the match starts. The waiver will be available at each match.

RULES: The current CMP Competition Rules will govern the conduct of this match. CMP Competition Rules are posted on the CMP web site at [Competition Rulebooks - Civilian Marksmanship Program](#).

CLASSIFICATION AND CATEGORIES: For Vintage Sniper, there are two categories, one for semi-automatic rifles and one for manually-operated rifles. If a team is firing both semi-automatic and manually-operated rifles, the team will be placed in the manually-operated category. To accommodate as many shooters as we can, we will be including a third non-sanctioned category, "Traditional Hunting Rifle Sniper Team". The "Traditional Hunting Rifle Sniper Team", category is self-explanatory and intended for off the rack type rifles and optics. This is not for match rifles. If you have a variable power optic capable of greater than 10X, you will be required to turn it down to a maximum of 10X. If your optic is a fixed power greater than 10X, please inquire as we will try to accommodate as much as we can. This category will adhere to the intent and spirit of CMP Vintage Sniper Program.

AWARD SCHEDULE: Teams will be classified and compete within their classification as per CMP rules. CMP achievement awards/medals will be presented to sanctioned competitors as outlined in the CMP rulebook.

CMP RIFLE PURCHASE ELIGIBILITY: The CMP Certificate of Competition (available upon successful completion of the match) in one of these CMP matches meets the CMP requirement for proof of marksmanship participation for purchasing rifles from the CMP. SAFETY: Safety is paramount. Each shooter must provide eye and ear protection. Empty Chamber Indicators must be used and may be borrowed for use at the match or may be purchased from the match director for a \$1 each.

COURSE OF FIRE: The Course of Fire is detailed in rule 7.5.1.

DISTANCES TO BE FIRED: The CRPC Outdoor High-Power range will be used to fire at 300 and 600 yards.

TARGETS: The Official SR-3 300 yard and MR 600 yard Military Targets will be used.

RIFLES: Each competitor should provide his or her rifle as stated in Table 8. Rule 3.7.4 states that Match Sponsors may, at their option, allow competitors to fire unlimited and special military rifles. These competitors will be recorded as firing out of competition (open individual category) and will not be eligible to win awards.

AMMUNITION: Each competitor is required to provide their own safe ammunition.
